# SUMMER CAMP BOARDING FACILITIES & EXTRAS

## HOUSING

The boarding facility is envisioned to be a house with shared & single rooms, bathrooms, common relaxation areas and dining facilities.

## BOARDER PERSONAL CARE

A care giver shall be a resident member of staff.

Offsite care is provided in the form of a house/care coordinator, cooking, cleaning, laundry, maintenance & driver.

## FACILITIES

Household cleaning will be done daily and laundry twice weekly (beginning of 2<sup>nd</sup> week).

All bedding and towels are provided and changed once weekly.

Swimming towels are not provided.

A high level of hygiene is provided and expected – students should bath daily.

## MEALS

Breakfast will comprise of fruit, cereal, milk, juice, water, yoghurt and varied sandwiches.

Dinners of a balanced healthy diet, soup, fish/meat, a portion of potato/pasta/rice, vegetables/salad and a dessert.

Weekend Lunches may be a little less healthy and fun, with at least 1 day eating out.

Nibbles will be available for morning and afternoon snacks during the weekend.
